Course Aide Demo Rider Rules:

_____ I understand that Course Aides that perform riding demonstrations and simulated practice demonstrations must be a minimum of 16 years of age and have a valid motorcycle license.

_____ I understand Course Aides may conduct riding demonstrations during a motorcycle training course if asked for and approved by the RiderCoach(s) in charge of the training. **This is only allowed once the Course Aide has successfully passed the WMSP Course Aide Workshop. Riding demonstrations must be under the direct supervision of the RiderCoach.**

_____ I understand Course Aides may conduct simulated-practice demonstrations during a motorcycle training course if asked for and approved by the RiderCoach(s) in charge of the training. **This is only allowed once the Course Aide has successfully passed the WMSP Course Aide Workshop. The course aide may not provide any of the verbal instruction during a simulated-practice demo. Simulated -practice demonstrations must be under the direct supervision of the RiderCoach.**

Course Aide Demo Rider Responsibilities:

_____ I understand that Course Aides conducting riding demonstrations during the motorcycle training course must know and understand the evaluation points of the demonstration and provide the demonstration utilizing proper techniques at novice speeds.

_____ I understand that Course Aides providing simulated-practice demonstrations during the motorcycle training course must know and understand the purpose of the demonstration and provide the demonstration utilizing proper techniques. **Only non-verbal portions of the simulated-practice demonstration may be provided.**

I understand the following RiderCoach Responsibilities when using a Course Aide for riding demonstrations and/or simulated practice demonstrations:

- _____ Ensure Course Aides are authorized by the sponsor training site to be present and perform duties assigned before the course begins.
- _____ Directly supervise the Course Aide to ensure that only non-instructional support is being offered throughout the course.
- _____ Only allow Course Aides to ride exercise demonstrations under RiderCoach supervision.
- _____ Ensure exercise riding demonstrations are performed according to the curriculum standards.
- _____ Only allow Course Aides to provide simulated-practice demonstrations under your direct supervision. Only non-verbal support may be provided.
- _____ If a Quality Assurance Visit (QAV) is conducted during a course utilizing a Course Aide, the RiderCoach(s) shall provide a riding exercise demonstration(s) as asked for by the Quality Assurance Specialist. It would be a normal expectation to see both the RiderCoach(s) and the Course Aide (if being utilized for riding demonstrations) ride during a QAV
- _____ Dismiss the Course Aide if they fail to follow the above listed WMSP rules and responsibilities.
